3.1 Summary of Actions

3.2 Detailed Actions

Bujumbura, Burundi (January – April 2025)

- Food basket distribution to 20 vulnerable families
- Funding of medical care for people without resources
- School fees coverage for orphaned children

Rumonge, Burundi (September – November 2025)

- Emergency food distribution for 15 families
- Access to medical care for chronically ill patients
- Support for schooling of underprivileged children

Kigoma, Tanzania (September – October 2025)

- Installation of electricity in a local mosque (Kigoma)
- Food distribution to 10 beneficiary families

Uvira, DR Congo (October – November 2025)

- Emergency food aid for 5 vulnerable families
- Partial coverage of school fees
